Celerity Fiber Optic (CFO) cables are designed for Ultra HD in-room connections. A slim connector encloses the optical module and connects

directly to the source and display.

Power for the transmit side is supplied via HDMI 5V and power for the receiving side is supplied by an integrated 5V USB power cable. Celerity CFO cables will be available in 6ft, 10ft, 16ft and 25ft lengths and support 18Gbps. The slim diameter cable is easy to manage behind components and does not apply any cable-bend pressure on the connections.
